



Let's Talk About Perfectly Made

Discussion questions for ages 3 to 7 · Sunday school, story time, or bedtime

1. Mia looked at her friend's smooth, neat hair and wished her own curls were different. Have you ever wished something about you was different?

Let little ones share freely. There are no wrong answers here.

2. Mia whispered, “Maybe God made me wrong.” Why do you think she felt that way?

Gently name the feeling: comparing ourselves to others can make us feel not-enough.

3. What did Mia's mom read to her from the Bible?

“I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.” Psalm 139:14

4. “Fearfully” means God made you with great care, like He held His breath while making you. What do you think “wonderfully” means?

There is no one else in the whole world made exactly like you.

5. Mia's friends are each good at different things. What are some things God made YOU good at?

Celebrate every answer, big or small!



Keep Talking...

Part two · Close in prayer: thank God for making each of us on purpose

6. Is there anything about you that God made by mistake?

No! God never makes mistakes. Every child is made on purpose, by a God who loves them.

7. What can we remember to say when we feel like we are not enough?

"I am fearfully and wonderfully made!" Practice saying it out loud together.

8. Who in your life needs to hear that they are wonderfully made? How could you tell them this week?

A sibling, a friend at school, a grandparent. Encourage one concrete kind act.
